Subject: A Sure Hope:

There is only one dependable event to hope for in the world, and that is for the first resurrection. The first resurrection is a hope that will not disappoint those who are saved. All other things that people hope for in the world is vanity if they are not supported by the promises of God.

The first resurrection that will take place upon Jesus' second appearance is the promise of God for all who are saved. To have a hope to live again exceeds all limited pleasures of this world. Jesus came and gave us a hope that cannot be annulled or fade away. That hope is though we die, we can live again, and the second life will be eternal.

Subject: The Separation:

Subject: Which Book Is Your Name In?
