Subject: Contradictions Must Come:

When you start with the Lord and testify that God has made your life sinless, the world and its religious sects will contradict you. Such contradictions must come because they contradicted Jesus, but they cannot stop you. You must look to Jesus, who withstood such contradictions, yet there was no sin or guile ever found in his mouth. Today Jesus sits on the right hand of God, and is able to help all who are willing to obey his gospel. Every opposer of a child of God will be Jesus' footstool. For the things that Jesus suffered, you must suffer also, but on a lesser scale. If you die in Christ, you will live again.

Subject: Your Record Is On High (Job 16:19):

God is keeping a record of everything that is said and done in his name; and he is keeping a record of all that is said and done in sin. God is an excellent record keeper, and though you may have forgotten many things you have said or done in sin, God does not forget. Unless you repent of your sins and receive the Holy Spirit of God to correct and change the course of your life of sin, your record will be reviewed on the Day of Judgment and used against you unto eternal damnation. A bad record before God will cause you to spend eternity with the damned.

Today you can choose the people that you would like to be in your company, but if you spend eternity with the damned, you will be forced to be in the company of Adolph Hitler, the Boston Strangler, Jack the Ripper, and every evil person that history has ever recorded. A bad record in this life will bring worse results in the next life that you will not be able to deal with. God only wants people who are pure in heart to spend eternity in his kingdom. You must prove that you are pure in heart by living a life according to the teachings of God's word in this world. The grace of God will help you to be able to do this if you repent with the intention to live a life free from sin. Titus 2:11-14 read as follows:

Verse 11 - For the grace of God that bringeth salvation hath appeared to all men,

Verse 12 - Teaching us that, denying ungodliness and worldly lusts, we should live soberly, righteously, and godly, in this present world;

Verse 13 - Looking for that blessed hope, and the glorious appearing of the great God and our Saviour Jesus Christ;

Verse 14 - Who gave himself for us, that he might redeem us from all iniquity, and purify unto himself a peculiar people, zealous of good works.

When you repent with a mind to obey God, he blots out the record of your transgressions that would have been held against you. Colossians 2:13-14 reads as follows:

Verse 13 - And you, being dead in your sins and the uncircumcision (uncleanness) of your flesh, hath he quickened together with him, having forgiven you all trespasses;

Verse 14 - Blotting out the handwriting of ordinances that was against us, which was contrary to us, and took it out of the way, nailing it to his cross;

Subject: The Evidence That You Believe The Gospel Is When You Obey It: (St. John 1:12)

When a person believes the gospel, Jesus gives them the power to obey the gospel. So then, the only way you can know that you believe the gospel is when you receive the ability to obey. The power of the Holy Spirit gives you the ability to obey the gospel. In the book of St. John 1:12 it reads like this:

Verse 12 - But as many as received him, to them gave he power to become the sons of God, even to them that believe on his name:

Believing is obeying. Your belief in the gospel must be confirmed by your obedience to the gospel, or else your believing will be a false testimony of Jesus' true existence.

Many people observed the works of Jesus, and they knew that no man had ever done such notable miracles, yet when Jesus told them that he was the Son of God, and

it was God's power doing the work, many did not believe that he was the Son God. In the book of St. John 14:11 it reads:

Verse 11 - Believe me that I am in the Father, and the Father in me: or else believe me for the very work's sake.

To believe that a work or miracle is not by the person who did it, yet you saw the work, is to deny that the miracle or work has been done. To reject the means, by which the work has been done, means that you have accepted the work that you see as being a lie or false work. You cannot truthfully accept something that has been done as being a reality unless you accept the means by which it was done. It is the means by which it was done that brought it into reality, or made its existence true.

A house is not a house just because you see it as being a house; what you see could be a picture or billboard. However, the only way you can accept the house as being a true house is to accept the fact that a man had to build the house. Houses only come into existence by someone building them. If the man who builds the house has been denied as being the builder of the house, then though you see the house you have to accept the fact that the house does not exist; one cannot be true without the other being true. If the construction of the house is made false, then the existence of the house is also false. The house is no more real than the construction of it. The house did not come into existence by you looking at it, but by the man who constructed it. You seeing the house did not make it exist, but the construction of it did. The construction of the house makes it a greater reality than did you seeing the house.

So then to deny that the man who constructed the house did the work, is to make the existence of the house false, though the house truly exist, but the person who testified that the man who built it, did not build it, has a false testimony of a true house. No real estate company can sell a house without a deed giving the true testimony that it exist, though the house does actually exist. Along with the existence of something, there must be a true testimony of its existence, or else its true existence is not accepted. Such a house cannot be bought or sold, because without a deed testifying of the existence, its existence is of non-effect, then it has no more meaning than if it did not exist at all.

To say that you believe the gospel of Jesus Christ, and not obey it does not make Jesus non-existent, but it gives you a false testimony of a true Jesus. To have a false testimony of something or somebody who actually exist, presents a false picture of their existence to others. Though the person actually exist, but if nobody accepts the fact that the person does exist, then the person's true existence is of non-effect, and this is just like not existing at all.

Jesus is a reality, but not to those who have a false testimony of Christ, simply because they fail to obey. Failure to obey the gospel makes you a false witness for a

true and living Saviour. Though Jesus exists, his existence is not substantiated through those who have false testimonies by their disobedience to his gospel.
