**Subject: Righteousness Will Indwell The Hearts Of Those In  
The New Heaven And Earth:**

God's purpose for the future civilization of saved people is to establish a habitation for righteousness that they may be ruled by the righteousness of God in their hearts. Listen to II Peter 3:12-13:

Verse 12 - Looking for and hasting unto the coming of the day of God, wherein the heavens being on fire shall be dissolved, and the elements shall melt with fervent heat?

Verse 13 - Nevertheless we, according to his promise, look for new heavens and a new earth, wherein dwelleth righteousness.

The presence of God is with you, if you will obey Him and keep His commandments. His goodness will prepare a blessed life for you while you are in this present world, and a continuous blessed life throughout eternity in the new kingdom. God promotes and exalts your spiritual status when you are faithful and obedient. In the new kingdom you will be promoted from a position of trust and faithfulness in this present world to a position of control and rule in the new kingdom. You will be able to set up your own agenda of rulership in the new kingdom without interfering with others in the kingdom. You will be self-ruled to live and to enjoy the privileges of the new kingdom along with others.

To every born again child of God, there are two things that God has promised. One is eternal life, and the other is the inheritance of the new earth. The day will come when God will fulfill His promises to us. In the new kingdom every person will have full control of themselves, and nobody will be able to make them do other than the will of God.

This is the purpose for which God has saved you. Though you may now work in the service for others, you are also in like manner as a child would be who was born into a wealthy family. The child would be no different from the servants of the family. One day the child will become an adult to be ruler of the estate. This world is presently in the authority of men who rule it by law, but God shall bring to

pass that those who are now in authority will no longer be here. The wicked shall be cut off (Malachi 4:1). Listen to Psalm 37:9-11:

Verse 9 - For evildoers shall be cut off: but those that wait upon the Lord, they shall inherit the earth.

Verse 10 - For yet a little while, and the wicked shall not be: yea, thou shalt diligently consider his place, and it shall not be.

Verse 11 - But the meek shall inherit the earth; and shall delight themselves in the abundance of peace.

### **Subject: The Hope Of The Resurrection:**

There are many people who believe that humans came into existence through evolution. It is not reasonable that we came into existence for us to exist no more. God offers us eternal life; He did not bring us into existence to die. Adam caused us to die by allowing sin to disrupt the human life cycle. After Adam sinned, God set in motion the resurrection of the dead.

The entire foundation of the Christian faith is based upon the resurrection of the dead. There is no promise to mankind that is more substantial than the hope of the resurrection. When you have faith in the promise of the resurrection, nothing has power to annul that hope.

### **Subject: Wait On The Harvest:**

You must have a mind with good intentions to receive the word of God; otherwise, an enemy will come along, and interfere with you keeping the word of God, thereby preventing you from being saved. Listen to St. Matthew 13:19:

Verse 19 - *When any one heareth the word of the kingdom, and understandeth it not, then cometh the wicked one, and catcheth away that which was sown in his heart. This is he which received seed by the way side.*

You must have a mind that is hungering and thirsting after righteousness or an enemy, who is the devil, will prevent you from receiving the word of God. The word of God is like a seed that a farmer sows. The seed must be sowed on good ground in order for it to bring forth fruit; otherwise, the birds of the air will come along and eat the seeds.

Your mind must be like good ground to receive and keep the word of God. When you hear the word of God, you must pay earnest attention to what it is saying or the devil will fill your mind with meaningless information to distract your attention from the word of God.

The purpose of the word of God is to bring fruit unto righteousness, which is the fruit of the Holy Spirit, but if you are not giving careful attention to the word of God, you will be like a person who is asleep while an enemy is planting trash in his mind. Listen to St. Matthew 13:24-25:

Verse 24 - Another parable put he forth unto them, saying, *The kingdom of heaven is likened unto a man which sowed good seed in his field;*

Verse 25 - *But while men slept, his enemy came and sowed tares among the wheat, and went his way.*

The good seed is the word of God that was given to the people of the earth to learn the righteousness of God so that they might be saved. However, Satan came along and filled the earth with unrighteousness, which was like tare, or bad seeds to interfere with the good seeds. Today we have good people in the world as well as evil people. However, God will not, at this time, separate the good from the evil, because the good people get their strength from persecutions of the evil people. Listen to verses 27-30:

Verse 27 - *So the servants of the householder came and said unto him, Sir, didst not thou sow good seed in thy field? from whence then hath it tares?*

The question is, why are there so many evil people in the world?

Verse 28 - *He said unto them, An enemy hath done this. The servants said unto him, Wilt thou then that we go and gather them up?*

Verse 29 - *But he said, Nay; lest while ye gather up the tares,*

*ye root up also the wheat with them.*

Verse 30 - *Let both grow together until the harvest: and in the time of harvest I will say to the reapers, Gather ye together first the tares, and bind them in bundles to burn them: but gather the wheat into my barn.*

So God will allow the unsaved to be in the world with the saved until the day of harvest when He will separate the righteous from the wicked

### **Subject: If You Are Saved You Are Ripe For The Harvest:**

Jesus sought very carefully to give the people on the earth an understanding of heavenly things by using earthly examples or parables. God is going to send Jesus with angels from heaven to harvest that which is saved from the earth. Listen to Revelation 14:15:

Verse 15 - *And another angel came out of the temple, crying with a loud voice to him that sat on the cloud, Thrust in thy sickle, and reap: for the time is come for thee to reap; for the harvest of the earth is ripe.*

Those who are born again are going to be gathered with Jesus like wheat is gathered by a farmer into the garner. The day is coming when the world is going to be on fire, and everything that is not saved will be on fire. The fire will not eradicate the existence of the unsaved; the unsaved will be changed and prepared for the judgment of God. The death that the unsaved will experience by fire will be only for a moment. It is the penalty and punishment that the unsaved receives after the judgment that will give them everlasting torment.

Christ, whom God sent into the world to teach the people of the earth about the harvest, will one day soon give a realistic demonstration of what He previously taught about the harvest. Christ is going to sickle the world. Those who are born again will be saved and caught up to meet the Lord. They will be the precious fruit of the earth that the husbandman was waiting for, and they will be considered as being ripe for the harvest. Listen to James 5:7:

Verse 7 - *Be patient therefore, brethren, unto the coming of the Lord. Behold, the husbandman waiteth for the*

precious fruit of the earth, and hath long patience  
for it, until he receive the early and latter rain.

The latter rain will be another out-pouring of the Holy Spirit to give the people of the earth another chance to be saved. This out-pouring will administer the last roundup for those who will be saved.
