Subject: The Holy Spirit Is An Anti-Sin Power:

You live free from sin by not having a desire to commit sin. This process of being free from sin is the results of the Holy Spirit coming into your life, and giving you holy or sin-free desires to replace your sinful desires.

The Holy Spirit is a carrier of God's holiness. It carries the holy power of God to those who repent of their sins and desire to obey God. The holy power of God is the sin-free nature of God. When you are sin-free, you are born again.

Sin is no formidable competitor to the power of the Holy Spirit. When the Holy Spirit comes into your life, sin has no power to stay in your life. The Holy Spirit installs within your desires an anti-sin power that will make sin repulsive to you. It will help you to be able to identify every sin that the Bible teaches of, and give you the strength, wisdom, and ability to reject such sins.

Subject: The Other Comforter:

Listen to one of the most important prayer request that Jesus presented to God for the world in St. John 14:16-17:

Verse 16 - *And I will pray the Father, and he shall give you another Comforter, that he may abide with you for ever;*

Verse 17 - *Even the Spirit of truth; whom the world cannot receive because it seeth him not, neither knoweth him: but ye know him; for he dwelleth with you, and shall be in you.*

It takes two parts of God to enter a person to be saved. God exists in three parts, which are the Father, the Son, and the Holy Ghost. God sent the second part of Himself to the earth, which is the word of God (Jesus) and Jesus prayed that God would send the third part, which is another Comforter, or the Holy Ghost to save those who would receive the second part who is Jesus.

Jesus brought the gospel from heaven to introduce the plan of salvation to the world. When a person receives the gospel, then Jesus prayed that the third part of God would make their salvation complete. The other Comforter, or the Holy Ghost is what gives a person the new birth in Christ. The Holy Ghost is the finality of a person's salvation. It makes the person a completely new creature in Christ.

The Holy Spirit is the Spirit of truth that will dwell with a person who receives Jesus, and will be in the person forever. The Holy Ghost never leaves a born again child of God. When you are filled with the Holy Ghost, you are born of God. Though you may not be able to see God, you will feel His presence, and assistance in your life. God will be a part of all of your movements, purposes and desires. God will be controlling your life by means of new, holy desires that the Holy Spirit will put in your nature. You would have experienced an implantment of God's divine nature, replacing your former carnal nature.

The Holy Spirit will make you holy in every aspect of your new life. You will then become God's workmanship, programmed by God to do good works for the rest of your life on earth. All of these changes took place in your life because Jesus prayed to God to send another Comforter to the earth to make salvation complete in those who believed His gospel.

Subject: Another Comforter:

Jesus prayed to the Father before He left the earth that God would send another Comforter to the earth that would be the Holy Ghost. St. John 14:16-17:

Verse 16 - *And I will pray the Father, and he shall give you another Comforter, that he may abide with you for ever;*

Verse 17 - *Even the Spirit of truth; whom the world cannot receive, because it seeth him not, neither knoweth him: but ye know him; for he dwelleth with you, and shall be in you.*

When you receive the Holy Ghost, it will come into your life and stay with you for the remaining of your life on earth, and continue to remain with you throughout

eternity after you enter the kingdom of heaven. This was a promise of Jesus to His disciples and to all who are saved.

The disciples did not desire for Jesus to leave them after experiencing the love and comfort that Jesus gave them. Jesus brought wonderful peace and joy into their lives. They had seen Jesus bind broken hearts, set at liberty the captive, open the eyes of the blind, cause the deaf to hear, and the dumb to speak, and preach the gospel to the poor. Jesus had been a comforter to those who loved Him, but now He was telling them that He had to leave so that another Comforter would come.

The gospel of the kingdom of heaven was the most consoling thing that God had ever sent to the earth. Today we continue to have glad tidings and good news in the gospel along with the availability of the other Comforter that Jesus promised. The gospel offers us promises from God without respect of persons.

In order to get the benefit of the promises of God, the Holy Ghost that Jesus promises will prepare you by making you pure, holy, upright and honest. When you have these qualities, you will be able to further construct a new life in Christ with the assistance of the Comforter.

Subject: The World Cannot Receive The Other Comforter:

Jesus wanted His apostles to realize and understand by His words that they should not be troubled, and that He would not leave them comfortless. Jesus told them that God had given Him power to fulfill all the promises that God sent Him to preach. Jesus had informed them that though they would die they would live again, and the proof of them receiving eternal life would be in His death and resurrection. He instructed them that they should not be troubled by His crucifixion, because on the third day He shall arise, and ascend to the Father. The time had come for Jesus to climax His visit to the earth, and that God would allow them to go through these experiences so that they would learn that God has something better for them. Therefore, these experiences, which may bring death to some of you, should not become a terror to you.

Now after Jesus goes back to the Father, He is going to petition to God to send another Comforter in His stead, which will be the Spirit of truth that the world will not be able to receive. Those who did not receive Christ in person or His teachings today will not be able to receive the other Comforter when it comes. Listen to St. John 14: 19-20:

Verse 19 - *Yet a little while, and the world seeth me no more;
but ye see me: because I live, ye shall live also.*

Verse 20 - *At that day ye shall know that I am in my Father,
and ye in me, and I in you.*
